Heat waves: the areas most at risk in the Milan area

The Metro Adapt project working group has collected temperature data on the hottest nights of the last 4 years. Afterwards, these data have been cross-checked with those on the resident population and the most vulnerable in terms of health. The analysis shows that 24% of the entire metropolitan city of Milan is exposed to the heat island phenomenon, with Corsico, Milan and Sesto San Giovanni as the municipalities most at risk.

Metro Theater: the caravan of climate shows has arrived in the municipalities of Milan!


